Introduction:

Emergency Building Evacuation Plan and LP Gas Fire Safety Demonstration was organized, providing participants with both theoretical knowledge and hands-on demonstrations. Fire safety awareness is important for ensuring the safety and protection of individuals in emergency situations. To promote emergency safety and disaster risk reduction, everyone must have a safety awareness. The event provided participants with essential knowledge to tackle a fire emergency situation with calmness and safety precautions to follow to avoid further casualties.

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Summary;

Emergency Building Evacuation Plan and LP Gas Fire Safety Demonstration session was led by Senior Fire Expert Mr. Kishor Kumar Bhattarai that began with a presentation on fire prevention, evacuation procedures, and the importance of staying calm during a fire emergency. The participants were informed about the precautions to take before, during, and after a fire emergency. Participants also



learned how to safely put out a fire involving a gas cylinder and what to do if petrol catches fire. After the presentation, participants were divided into groups for a practical evacuation drill. They practiced different rescue methods, including carrying injured people using stretchers and using two-person and three-person rescue techniques. The drill was carried out in a realistic emergency setting with sirens and the use of emergency exits. Participants also learned how to respond safely to fires involving gas cylinders and were given demonstrations on handling such emergencies properly.

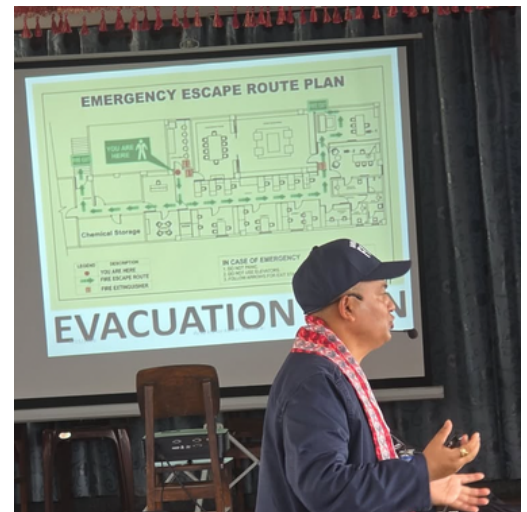
